Shortly, the bottom of the crucible should turn orange-red. Heat the crucible for 5 minutes after the bottom has turned color. Remove the crucible from the wire triangle using your crucible tongs. Place the crucible on a wire gauze and allow it to cool for 2 minutes (must be cool to the touch). Carry the crucible using your crucible tongs.
