Examples of the Assessments: Grade 6, Junior ... - EQAO

The Assessment of Reading, Writing and Mathematics, Junior Division (Grades 4–6) tests the reading, writing and math skills students are expected to have learned by the end of Grade 6. Students write this test during a two-week testing window in May/June each year.

Grade 6 Junior Division Assessment - EQAO

EQAO releases approximately half of its test questions (called “items”) each year. This process allows EQAO to build up a bank of items that can be used in future years. Note: When you open a downloaded Zip folder, save the individual files to your computer. This will help ensure your files open and run properly.
